

OUR BELIEFS

THE SCRIPTURES - The Bible is the Inspired Word of God, written by men of God, guided by the Holy Spirit. We accept the unchangeable Scriptures as our guide for conduct and doctrine. 2 Timothy 3:16; 1 Thessalonians 2:13; 2 Peter 1:21.

THE DIVINITY - There is only One God, but He manifests Himself in Three Persons: The Father, The Son and The Holy Spirit, which forms The Holy Trinity. God the Father is the Almighty, The One that sent the Word and is the Grand Architect. John 14:28; 16:28; John 1:14. The Son is the Word made flesh and has existed from the beginning with the Father. John 1:14; 1:18; 1:1. The Holy Spirit proceeds from both the Father and the Son. He gives substance to the Word and is eternal. John 15:26.

MANKIND, HIS FALL & REDEMPTION - Mankind was created in the image and likeness of God. But through the transgression and fall of Adam, sin came into the world. Romans 3:23; 6:23; 3:10. Jesus Christ, the Son of God, manifested Himself in order to destroy the works of the devil. He gave His life and shed His blood in order to redeem and restore mankind with God. Romans 5:12; Colossians 1:13-14; Ephesians 2:16-18; 1 John 3:8.

ETERNAL LIFE - Jesus Christ is the only road that leads mankind to God. Anyone who believes that Jesus paid the price for our sins and receives Him as their Lord and Savior will be saved and have eternal life with God. The first step for a person to obtain eternal life with God is through Repentance, resulting in a New Birth not of the flesh, but of the Spirit, the inner man. It is this experience that produces eternal life with God. John 3:3-5; 2 Corinthians 7:10; 1 John 5:12-13.

SALVATION - We believe that salvation can only be obtained here on earth, and not after death. It cannot be obtained by means of our own works of charity or any other human deeds, neither by attending a church. Salvation is obtained by the Grace of God through Faith and is at our disposal through the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross. In order to receive Salvation, a person has to believe in the Redemptive Word of Jesus Christ and, proclaim Jesus as their Lord and Savior. Ephesians 2:8-9; Acts 4:12; Romans 10:8-10; Hebrews 9:23-

DIVINE HEALING - It is the will of God to cure people today and always, whether they are saved or not, from all types of illnesses. We believe that with Faith in The Promises of God, it is possible to receive healing for physical and

psychological ailments and to remain in good health. Divine Healing is manifested through faith by the laying of hands or through the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. It has been made available by the sacrifice of Jesus and is the right of every Christian today. James 5:15-16; Mark 16:18; Isaiah 53:4-5; Matthew 8:17; 1 Peter 2:24; Psalm 103:3; Psalm 107:20.

WATER BAPTISM - This is a commandment of Jesus for all believers, which is performed by means of immersing the whole body in water. We do not baptize babies because baptism is for the remission of sins and a step of faith, which is not possible for a baby. It is an external act that identifies a believer with Christ in His death and resurrection. Matthew 28:19; Romans 6:4; Colossians 2:12; Acts 2:36-39.

INAUGURATION THE VISION CONTINUES

"but they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.

o the journey began and the Vision was implemented on that cold morning of November 12, 2000, weathering the fierce elements - Pastor Angelo Barbosa, his wife Elizabeth and ten (10) devoted believers gathered in the rundown basement of an old Baptist Church at 515 Dean Street, Brooklyn NY, for that first prayer meeting. Neither the humble beginnings nor the freezing temperatures could put a damper on the fire of God that burned within their hearts, the only heat present in the building. Fully clad in their winter jackets, hats, scarves and gloves but focused and determined, they fervently praised and worshiped the Lord for what He had done and what He was about to reveal in this new ministry. Infused with Pastor Angelo's Vision, their eyes were set on the prospects of hope and a promising tomorrow.

Stepping out on the waters of "crazy faith" they followed the leading of the Holy Spirit, Who imparted directions to Pastor Angelo and Ms. Liz (as his wife is affectionately called), into a small section of this dilapidated, rented basement that came with lots of stringent rules and regulations, unappealing walls, and defaced, wooded floors and falling apart. The assortment of chairs that were used for the service were old, decrepit and multi-

colored; there was no uniformity or harmony to the surroundings, which came with stern consequences if they even remotely exceeded the allocated space and time.

Not withstanding, these faithful stewards in obedience, carefully observed these rules with smiles and purpose and served within the limitations that were set. It was only a short period of time before their faith was realized and the Lord gave Pastor Angelo uncommon favor by expanding the space they were utilizing to the entire basement. This opportunity was received as a great source of encouragement to them even though there was still scarcity of heat and comfort.

By this time, the Lord had heavily impressed on Bishop's heart to call the ministry, "The Temple of Restoration." With the name of the ministry in place, coupled with the memorable motto "Where Jesus Christ Is Changing Lives," they continued to meet on a regular basis. The main thrust of the ministry was geared towards deliverance and restoration, and word began to spread like wild fire about what was unfolding and what God was doing in this faithful ministry. People came from all walks of life to hear The Word, to be healed, to worship and to testify. It was no wonder that by the end of the first year, the membership grew to over two hundred strong.

Subsequently, with the ardent support of the parishioners, renovations of the basement were set in motion. With hands and hearts together, they embraced the "good work" as they candidly called it with joy. In a short period of time, they were able to welcome the arrival of brand new carpeting and matching chairs. "This was a great blessing!" Ms. Liz recalls.

With the increased growth and success of the ministry, by the end of that first year of "new beginnings," several churches were planted in South Africa, Massachusetts, and in Queens, New York at the Harvest Room.

It became very apparent that the limited space could no longer accommodate the zealous crowds of people that came to experience the power of God. Like an unstoppable herald, the astonishing testimonies that were dispersed abroad soon resulted in parishioners flying in from domestic and international locations to simply participate in the services.

Favor continued to be with Pastor Angelo and in 2005, he received an unprecedented opportunity to purchase the entire church building at 515 Dean Street! As things unfolded before his eyes, he was well aware of the gridlock opposing him financially. But like a bold warrior, he pressed forward despite the many setbacks. Consequently, God honored his faith, as well as the fidelity of his people and they were able to purchase the church without bank financing.

With the continued growth in the ministry, on May 16, 2010, Pastor Angelo was elevated and anointed Bishop Angelo. A responsibility he wore with humility and thanks giving as he continued to lead the people. And the Lord spoke to him, "Go up to the hills and bring wood and build the house, that I may take pleasure in it and that I may be glorified, says the Lord." … "And the Lord stirred up the spirit of the people and they came and worked on the house of the Lord of Hosts, their God!" Haggai 1:8,14

This committed servant of God and his growing flock wasted no time in beginning the construction on the main sanctuary. Feverishly, a new heating and cooling system was installed. And with the spirit of excellence, they pursued the overall beautification of the Lord's house. It was a time to build and even though this restoration project was indeed an extraordinary task both in work and finances, the team readily accepted the challenges they faced. Through the sacrificial support of the members, covenant partners and friends of the ministry, the finances became available and miraculously, the work was completed.

By 2007, every square foot of the foundational building was being utilized. Now, decked with a plush décor that exudes an elegant and timeless ambiance, the entire complex reflects the lavish faithfulness of God. From the chic chandeliers to the fine wood furnishings, from the cushioned pews to the posh glass stained windows, it's obvious that Bishop Angelo is a man of impeccable taste and there is no offering too great to give to the Lord. At last, after the disciplined toil, the headquarters, the founding block, was inaugurated in June 2007, dedicated

and consecrated to be used for the sole purpose of God's work.

Spreading out from Brooklyn New York, this Pentecostal ministry is comprised of people from diverse cultural backgrounds. It has drastically grown from 12 members to more than several thousand members collectively in the USA and abroad. Churches continue to be planted in various parts of the world to include Cape Verde, Brazil, Trinidad and Tobago, South Africa and the Mountain Kingdom of Lesotho and domestically, Mt. Vernon, New Jersey, Staten Island, Queens, Rhode Island, and Massachusetts. Under the anointed leadership of Bishop Angelo as founder and senior Pastor, the Temple of Restoration continues to reflect the heartbeat of God as they spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ across the nations of the world. With a mission to reach the needy, the oppressed, and the less privileged and forgotten of society, the doors are open on a daily basis with most branches having four (4) services per day. With a tireless evangelical commission in place, the ministry is geared to facilitate the various needs of the people.

Services are held on Sundays at 7:30AM, 10AM, 3PM (Spanish at 515 Dean Street) and 6PM; daily services are held Monday thru Friday at 10AM, 12PM, 4PM and 7PM (service times vary at each location). Creole services are held at our Snyder location at 10AM every Saturday and 3PM every Sunday. Portuguese service is at 10AM every Sunday in New Jersey. Weekly services are thematic in nature, strategically designed to address the varied needs of parishioners, for example: Financial Restoration, Health Restoration, Bible Study & Spiritual Growth, Family Restoration, and Deliverance.

Today, November 12, 2017, The Temple of Restoration celebrates 17 years of service to the Lord, exactly 17 years to the day of that first service in such humble beginnings. One can see the awesome power of God as we consecrate and inaugurate the Cathedral located at 490 Pacific Street, the same location the Bishop rented to celebrate the first anniversary of the ministry. This location was acquired in 2012, now no longer a need to rent but owned by the ministry! All glory to God! And so the journey continues, with God making provisions for each step of the way!!!

The Temple of Restoration is indeed a place where Jesus Christ is changing lives every day!

PACIFIC CATHEDRAL RENOVATION

"One thing I have desired of the Lord, That will I seek: That I may dwell in the house of the Lord All the days of my life, To behold the beauty of the Lord, And to inquire in His temple." **Psalm 27:4**

erein lies the beginning of a new chapter. The grand opening of **The Temple of Restoration's** new Headquarter location at 490 Pacific Street in Brooklyn, New York is not so much the end of an era as it is the continuation of a legacy! Servants of God and laborers in the Kingdom have worked tirelessly over the past five years to build TTOR's Pacific Street Cathedral into the finished temple it is today: a safe haven for the lost, the broken and the blessed.

The Pacific Street cathedral is set to be the replacement location for TTOR's previous headquarters at 515 Dean Street in Brooklyn. We visited the new cathedral to learn the history of how it became a TTOR location and the progress of the renovation that had been taking place there since 2012.

The Pacific Street cathedral became a part of TTOR's history back in 2001 when the ministry celebrated its first anniversary dinner there. They intended to rent the space for one day to celebrate the church's anniversary, but the Lord had other plans.

Over a decade later, Bishop Angelo and the team set their sights on moving TTOR's headquarter branch from Dean Street to the Pacific Street cathedral. Pastor Walter "Junior" Black, is a TTOR Pastor who also served doing the electrical work on the Pacific Street renovation. He remembers that he used to accompany some of the TTOR senior pastors on periodic trips to the cathedral. At the time, he did not know why they were going there. The pastors would go to the building and march around it, anoint it, and pray over it with faith, while he sometimes waited for them in the car. He eventually learned that the servants of God at TTOR were believing for the acquisition of the historic cathedral, located in the heart of downtown Brooklyn.

Pastor Junior says he remembers eventually hearing Bishop Angelo say that the ministry had finally obtained the building where it held its first anniversary celebration! That was an exciting victory for the clergy, servants, members, partners and friends at The Temple of Restoration.

Many people all over the world are able to say they came to TTOR believing God by faith for a seemingly impossible task and received exactly what they petitioned heaven for. It was an encouragement for all those who got to see God grant such an enormous victory to a ministry whose beliefs are firmly rooted in the premise that nothing is too difficult for God!



When TTOR purchased the Pacific Street cathedral, the ministry didn't just obtain the building; they also obtained every item, antique, and piece of furniture that was inside. If you speak to certain assistants at TTOR, they will detail how they pulled together to host a yard sale for the community so the church could get rid of the items it inherited.

After clearing out the cathedral, then came the bigger challenge. TTOR was faced with the task of giving the entire cathedral a thorough renovation. Pastor Junior describes it as being a "lengthy process." He describes Bishop Angelo as being a person who likes the best for God. As a result, Pastor Junior savs there were times when workers at Pacific Street would do work in the building that ultimately ended up having to be changed (for example the room sizes, tiles, or the painting). This was because the quality of what was installed, as good as it may have been, did not match the quality of what Bishop Angelo envisioned for the cathedral! He says there were many days Bishop Angelo would be right there working beside them as though he was a construction worker to assist in the execution of his vision for the cathedral!

Pastor Junior admits there were times when he thought, "Why are we changing this?" But when he would see the end results of the changes, he had to agree they were much better! TTOR has imported materials from all over the world to ensure that the Pacific Street Cathedral matches the quality the ministry believes God's house so rightfully deserves.

"I believe God is going to do great wonders in that building because it was built in a special way. When people come in, they're going to realize that God is still in the business of taking care of His work," Pastor Junior says. He recounts there were many challenges in getting the Pacific Street cathedral to where it is today. There were times Bishop Angelo would give the workers a description of what he envisioned for the building and they would wonder how such a task could ever be accomplished.

Yet, though it was a challenge to bring the elaborate Pacific Street construction to its current beauty, the Pastor says it was well worth it. He testifies that the construction process was one that could not have been rushed. Workers had to take their time and sometimes even revisit and redo completed jobs in order for the finished cathedral to be what it is today.

When we think of the amount of souls that will be saved, children that will be dedicated, messages that will be preached, marriages that will take place, and people that will be healed at 490 Pacific Street, we at The Temple of Restoration would like to thank God for His faithfulness and commitment to His people. King David says in **Psalm 27:4,** "One thing I have desired of the Lord, that will I seek: That I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to inquire in His temple."

To the members, partners, friends and family of TTOR: We would like to welcome you to your new Temple. May you build great memories in this cathedral. May you and your family grow in the Love of the Lord in this House. Always remember that as God is taking His ministry, TTOR, from victory to victory, we believe the same blessing to prosper is also dwelling in the lives of those connected to The Temple of Restoration! God bless you and welcome home!

















Pastor Sherwin

1. VOR: What is your earliest memory or the moment you realized God was calling you to be a pastor?

Pastor Sherwin: It was the summer of 2007. I remember I was in the Young Adults Group and also a candidate in the Assistants Class. We, the young adults, would go and minister to the troubled and homeless young adults at a group home in Manhattan. From time to time, I was asked to prepare something biblical to deliver to them. This became a habitual request until I was asked to take full charge of the meetings. That was when I realized that God was preparing me for ministry.

2. VOR: At The Temple of Restoration, we believe that Jesus is changing lives here everyday. Can you tell us how God has changed your life at TTOR?

Pastor Sherwin: Prior to coming to the temple, my life was upside down. I struggled with alcohol, women and clubbing just to name a few. I wanted change but never knew how change was going to come. After accepting an invite to the temple, participating in the deliverance services and following the counsel that was given to me on how to live a better life, things began to change for me. What used to be my biggest struggles are gone today.

3. VOR: For many pastors, preaching the gospel was not necessarily what they had planned to do with their lives. What about you? What were your plans for your life before your call to ministry?

Pastor Sherwin: Well, I can attest to that statement. Being a pastor was never in my plans. Actually, my dream was to one day be a CEO of a top company in Manhattan and then go on to own my own sporting goods business. But God had a different plan as you can see today.

4. VOR: What do you believe it takes to be a good pastor in the world today?

Pastor Sherwin: That's a wonderful question. To be an effective pastor, I believe it takes a few key things: It takes commitment, dedication, willingness to learn, humility and a

passion for seeing other people's life story change. I also believe that in order to be an effective pastor, the needs of your calling and of the people must supersede your needs.

5. VOR: As you reflect on your time at The Temple of Restoration over the years, what would you say has been the passion and driving force behind the ministry?

Pastor Sherwin: The passion of the Temple of Restoration is seeing people experiencing restoration in every area and aspect of their lives. After salvation, that's our greatest desire for the people. As for the driving force behind this ministry, it's a combination of different things. I must say having great leadership is key, but having leaders who are leading by example and not by words also helps. I will also add that having pastors, assistants and even members who believe in the dream that God has given the Bishop also helps. Having people who are committed to your dream, want to see it happen, and are willing to do whatever it takes to see these dreams become a reality is key to driving TTOR forward.

6. VOR: Tell us about a recent experience that you had at The Temple of Restoration that is unique to you? **Pastor Sherwin:** I would say being used by God to pray for someone who had stage IV lung cancer. The doctors stated that he was in his final month; we prayed for him, and today he is cancer free. Why is this unique? Because that was one of the three things I asked God to use me to do when I started ministry, pray for someone who was on their dying bed.

7. VOR: Do you have any final thoughts you'd like to share with our readers?

Pastor Sherwin: As we celebrate our 17th year anniversary, I reflect on not just the good things that have happened for us, but also on the trials that couldn't stop us but because of faith, resilience and great leadership. We're here today to celebrate God's faithfulness. I encourage each reader to continue to make God your number one priority and to remain faithful to Him and to this ministry He has planted you in, for your faith, commitment and dedication will yield great results in every area and aspect of your life.

Pastor Kerlan

1. VOR: What is your earliest memory or the moment you realized God was calling you to be a pastor?

Pastor Kerlan: After realizing that God had not only saved my life but also changed my life, there was nothing more desirable for me than to serve God.

2. VOR: At The Temple of Restoration, we believe that Jesus is changing lives here every day. Can you tell us how God has changed your life at TTOR?

Pastor Dionne: My passion is to help people. I had a great position in the banking industry and I was successful at what I did. But I realized that I wasn't feeling fulfilled at what I was doing. There was a great void. I started to seek God more and my desire to serve Him grew. I realized I was talking to my clients about the power of God instead of their financial needs. It was at that point that I made the decision to stop dreaming my dream and dream God's dream.

2. VOR: At The Temple of Restoration, we believe that Jesus is changing lives here every day. Can you tell us how God has changed your life at TTOR?

Pastor Dionne: I walked into TTOR broken in all areas of my life and without hope. Today, when I look back at my life, I see God's power of restoration in my health, sentimental life, family, finances, etc. I have found hope in a relationship with God. Today, I am able to encourage and be a blessing to others.

3. VOR: For many pastors, preaching the gospel was not necessarily what they had planned to do with their lives. What about you? What were your plans for your life before your call to ministry?

1. VOR: What is your earliest memory or the moment you realized God was calling you to be a pastor?

I was a bit hesitant to answer because I looked at God's work as serious business and not for me, but for some reason the question stayed with me. Then one day, I felt this strong feeling in my heart to really go after this. I spoke to the Bishop about what God had placed in my heart and he told me to pray about it and come back to him. Pastor Aidan: Over the years, I see the love the Temple of Restoration has for the people. We may not be a perfect church, but we love the people no matter the pain and scars they carry.

6. VOR: Tell us about a recent experience that you had at The Temple of Restoration that is unique to you? **Pastor Aidan:** It was a prayer vigil and I felt the Presence of God so strong, stronger than I had ever felt before. His love was so powerful that I started crying and said, "Lord even if you don't bless me, I will still serve you." I was young in my faith then and I didn't fully understand the blessings of God. I thought it was just material, but I found out that I was already walking in His blessings.

7. VOR: Do you have any final thoughts you'd like to share with our readers?

Pastor Aidan: When we learn how to give 100% of our lives to God, we will also overcome 100%.

Q&A

VOR: How did you meet Bishop Angelo? Ida Wallace: Well my sister invited me to church and she told me about

this young pastor that was preaching. So I came to the church one Friday night. I didn't understand anything that was going on because I was coming from another denomination. From that time, I never left the church. I'm still here until today.

VOR: What was it like being in that first evening service? Ida Wallace: It was a great service. It wasn't a lot of us there. The church building was old, but we were happy to be there. I don't think we had more than twenty or twenty-five people there in the evening service. The morning service only had twelve people and we probably had just a few more in the evening service.

VOR: For the first few years at TTOR, what was the main goal of the ministry for you as an assistant?

Ida Wallace: The goal was to fix up the church building, make the church look beautiful and to win souls for Jesus. We didn't have much finances, but Jesus provided. We did our best. There were less than ten assistants at the time. We would buy the things that the church needed. Bishop would do the same. I don't know how many times we changed the design of the church. We would change the curtains, the design of the chairs. First, we had some orange chairs and they were so hard. Then we had blue chairs that were donated. Then in about a years time, Bishop bought his own chairs.

VOR: What's your earliest memory of TTOR doing a special service outside of 515 Dean Street?

Ida Wallace: I remember we went to Africa about three times. We went twice to South Africa. Then we went to Lesotho and Soshanguve to have special services for the people. That was the first time I remember The Temple of Restoration doing mission work.

VOR: Over the years, what are your favorite things that happened to you personally at TTOR?

Ida Wallace: God healed me. I was sick. Financially, I was sick. Physically, I was sick. I used to suffer with headaches and migraines. God took all of that away from me. God took away all my bills. I have no credit card bills. That could be my favorite thing that He did. He took my bills away. It's true! Also, my favorite thing is that I get to travel. I never thought in my life that I would have gotten to go to South Africa, Israel, Trinidad, Jamaica, Haiti, and Cape Verde.

VOR: What has been the most memorable service at TTOR for you?

Ida Wallace: All the services at TTOR are great, but I think one of the greatest ones was the ordination of Pastor Angelo to a Bishop. It was just special.


